Mona Sandbæk is a senior researcher at NOVA; Norwegian Social Research, Oslo. She holds a PhD in social work, from the University of Trondheim, Institute for Social work and Health Science. She has played an active role in many research projects, covering qualitative as well as quantitative research methods, often as a research co-ordinator. She is also involved in extensive international networking, including child research in the Middle East. In 1994/1995 she was a Fulbright Scholar at the University of Washington, School of Social Work, Seattle, USA. 2005-2006 she worked in the Council of Europe, DG III Social Cohesion, in a position seconded by the Norwegian Ministry of Children and Equality. She participated in CoEs work to promote children's rights and positive parenting and prevent violence against children.
