Angela Abela is a senior lecturer at the University of Malta where she is Course Director of the professional Masters programme in Clinical, Counseling and Educational psychology. Dr Abela also teaches family therapy trainees reading for an MSc at the Tavistock Clinic in London. She has published on marital conflict, children and families. She started her career as a school teacher in primary and secondary schools. Besides her academic commitment, she is also a practicing clinical psychologist and a family therapist and supervisor. Between 2002 and 2006 she chaired the National Family Commission in Malta.

Between 1998 and 2004 she held the position of President of the Maltese Psychological Association for two consecutive tenures. In 2005 she was elected by fellow psychologists to sit on the Malta Psychology Profession Board. Currently she is the international secretary of the Maltese Association of Family Therapy and Systemic Practice and represents this association at the National Family Therapy Organizations Forum within the European Family Therapy Association.

In 2005 she was appointed by the Council of Europe to be part of a European Working Party on Parenting Children at Risk of Social Exclusion. She holds a clinical Ph.D. in Children and Families from the Tavistock Clinic and the University of London, and a Masters degree in Clinical Psychology from the Universite de la Sorbonne Paris V.
