ASGHAR ZAIDI is Director Research at the European Centre Vienna and a Research Associate at the Centre for Analysis of Social Exclusion, London School of Economics, UK. Previously, he worked as Senior Economist at OECD, Paris; as Economic Advisor at the Department for Work and Pensions, and as a researcher at the London School of Economics and the University of Oxford. He is the Vice-President of the International Microsimulation Association, and has recently published books on microsimulation modelling and on well-being of older people in ageing societies.
