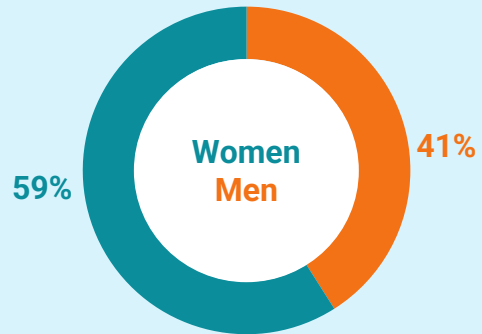




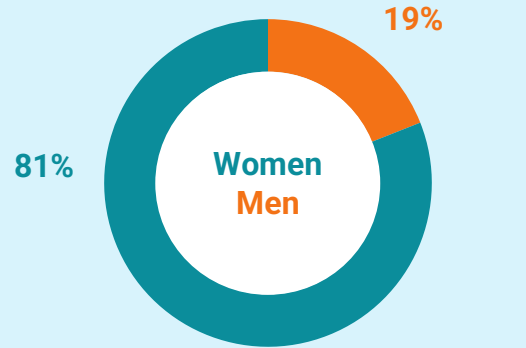

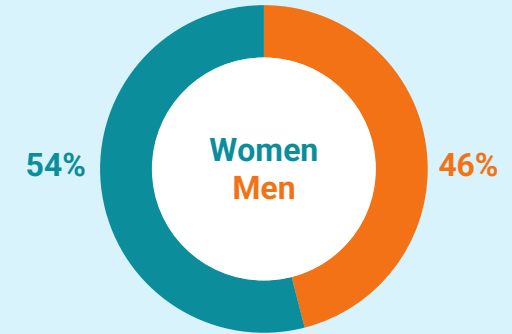
● The gender dimension of care and caring



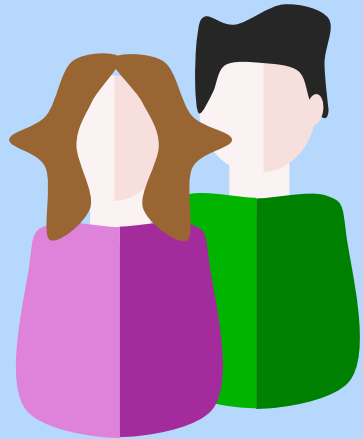
Gender distribution in informal care

People with long-standing limitations in usual activities due to health problems



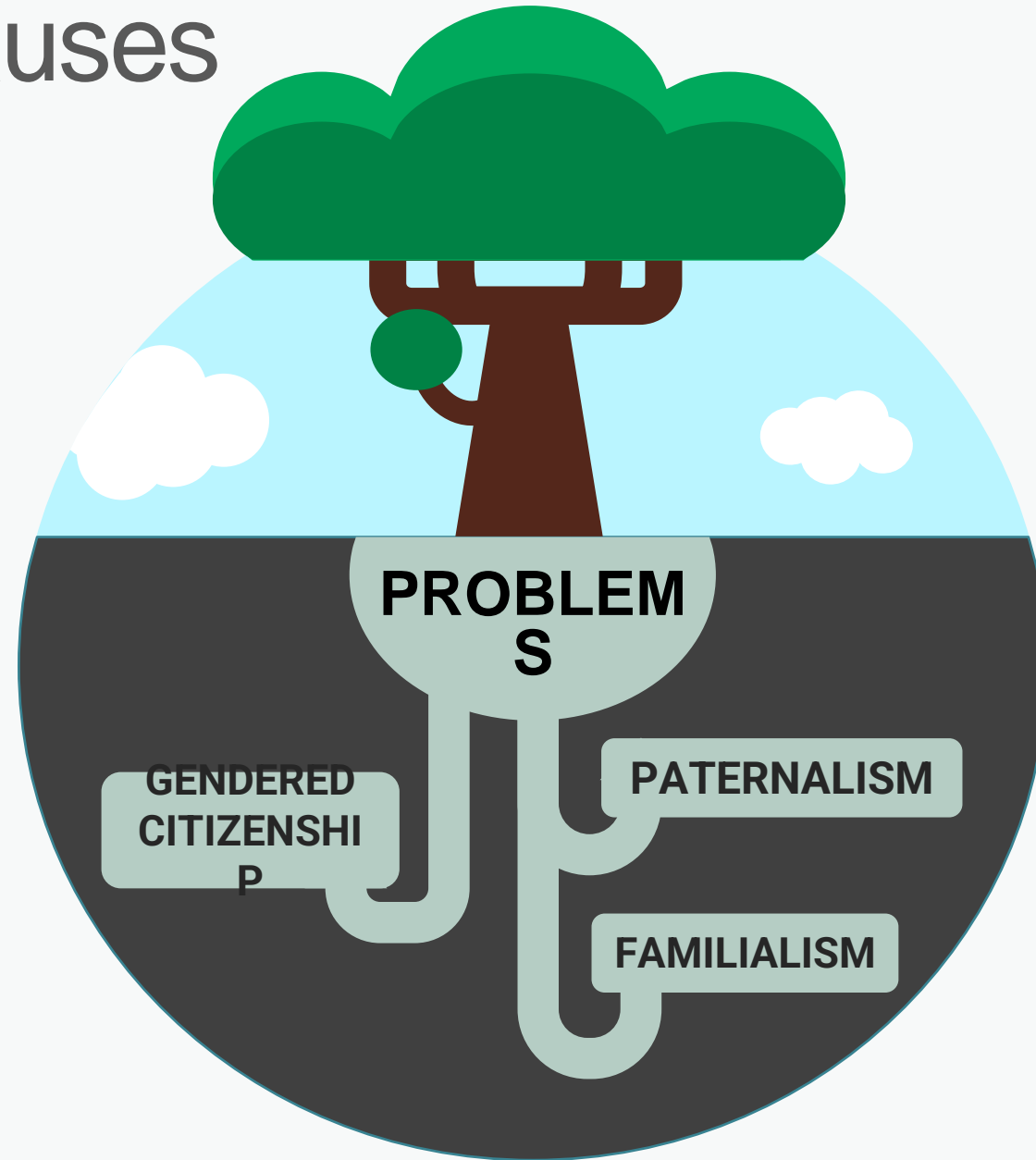
At least 44 million people
