Who are we?

The European Centre is a UN-affiliated applied research institute conducting comparative research and policy advice with our partners in the UNECE region focusing on Central and Eastern Europe including the Western Balkan and Eastern Partnership countries.

What is my internship about?

The intern will be involved in various tasks and research activities that are being carried out as part of national and international projects. The intern will have the opportunity to participate actively in project meetings as well as in wider institutional seminars and other activities. The internship will allow the successful candidate to acquaint themselves with the tasks and responsibilities of working in a research environment and to benefit from exchanges with colleagues on a wide range of subjects in the fields of employment, labour mobility, platform economy, new forms of work, and social dialogue.

What do I need to qualify for this internship?

- A Bachelor's or Master's degree in social sciences and/or economics and/or social policy analysis
- Training in quantitative methods and the ability to carry out data cleaning, descriptive analyses and basic data visualisation tasks
- Working knowledge of STATA or R and Excel software packages
- Excellent oral and written command of English (C1 or higher), fluency in German is an advantage
- Basic understanding and interest in the fields of employment, labour mobility, platform economy, new forms of work, and social dialogue
- Team spirit and ability to work in a multicultural work environment on interdisciplinary aspects of social inclusion.

Other: The internship comes with a stipend of EUR 470 per month. The time commitment of the internship in terms of hours per week is flexible and will be determined together with the successful candidate.
