Dr. Niki Kalavrezou is a Team Leader of the Health and Care team at the European Centre for Social Welfare Policy and Research. She holds a PhD in Economics from the Athens University of Economics and Business (AUEB) and a doctoral diploma in Health Economics and Policy from the Swiss School of Public Health (SSPH+), completed in collaboration with the Universities of Geneva and Lausanne. Dr. Kalavrezou has over a decade of experience in applied social research in the areas of health, long-term care, inequality, labour, pensions and education. Her expertise includes applying various qualitative and quantitative research methods (mixed methods), such as survey data analysis and expert interviews, to deliver comprehensive and impactful research.
